

Exception Policy for Summer Ice Contracts

We know that the schools start and end at different times, and that timing may conflict with summer ice contracts. We are providing an exception process for those who may find themselves in this situation.

NOTE: All exceptions must meet the criteria listed below.

Exception Criteria:

- The member must be a SENIOR HOME CLUB MEMBER of SPFSC
- Exceptions must be submitted using the process below and received by the club Ice Monitor. Requests must be submitted by the following deadlines:
 - June 10, 8:00pm, for end of 2022 school year
 - August 15, 8:00pm, for beginning of 2023 school year
- The member must have purchased at least one CONTRACT for the summer
- Walk-on SESSION ice does not qualify for an exception
- Exceptions beyond the first week of the contract will not be accepted, and the number of contracts in the week cannot exceed 5
- The only available sessions to purchase Walk On Sessions are for:

If your exception is approved, you may choose one of the following Walk-On sessions:

- 3:45pm to 4:45pm session Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
- 5:00pm to 6:00pm session Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
