



Learn to Skate Policy

1. Registration opens 30 days prior to the start of each Learn to Skate contract.
2. Registrations are accepted online only and are first come, first served.
3. Classes are not pro-rated for missed lessons.
4. Make up lessons are not available to maintain established ratios.
5. New LTS beginners (Intro to Skating, Basic 1) may join up to week 3 of the contract if space is available.
6. Class Ratio: minimum 3 and maximum 10. Beginning levels are smaller and specialty classes may be larger.
7. Ages and levels may be combined due to low enrollment.
8. Class times may change due to enrollment. Participants will be notified.
9. Cancellation/refund policy- full refund/credits are given only when St. Paul FSC cancels a class or if requested 5 business days prior to the start of class. Refund requests will be assessed a \$5 administrative fee. Memberships are not refundable. Partial (prorated) refund/credits can be requested up to 24 hours prior to the second class meeting. See the SPFSC Injury policy for injury related refunds. Ice show registration fees may not be refunded once show practices have begun.
10. Weather Policy: the SPFSC will not cancel any Learn to Skate/Preschool Skate class due to weather unless Ramsey County makes the decision to close the facility
11. Evaluations will be given to all participants in a leveled class.
12. Learn to Skate USA testing will be offered at the end of every contract. One patch will be awarded (if earned) to each participant. Participants may purchase additional patches.
13. Learn to Skate USA tests will be registered for all LTS USA members.
